J.A.S.E. (Jensen after School Experience). Located at Vince Bocchino Community Center, 2369 NE Dixie Hwy, Jensen Beach, FL 34957.

X-treme Teen (Programs are scheduled county-wide in all of Martin County)

R.E.A.C.H. (Residents Empowering All Children's Hope) Located at Costella Williams Learning Center, 4450 SE Field St., Stuart, FL 34997.

P.L.A.C.E. (Parks, Leisure, Arts, Culture and Education). Located at Big Mound Park, 15205 SW Indianmound Dr, Indiantown, FL 34956.


Martin County, through its Parks and Recreation Department (MCP&R) agrees to the following:

3. Work with collaborative partners to increase their participants'/clients' involvement in recreation, sports, fitness arts and cultural programs and activities.


The Department of Juvenile Justice agrees to the following:
