



**AGREEMENT TO OPERATE A  
Responding Against Delinquency and Recidivism  
R.A.D.A.R.  
PROGRAM IN THE CITY OF TALLAHASSEE**

This agreement is made and effective on the date signed by all parties, by and between the Department of Juvenile Justice, Circuit II; the Chief of Police, City of Tallahassee; the Tallahassee Marine Institute; and the Henry and Rilla White Foundation, Inc.

**WITNESSETH:**

**WHEREAS,** there is a need in the City of Tallahassee to monitor juvenile justice youth that meet the R.A.D.A.R. criteria for additional supervision,

**WHEREAS,** all parties are committed to providing services to the identified youth to prevent them from re-offending,

**WHEREAS,** all parties mutually agree that all obligations stated or implied in this agreement shall be interpreted in light of, and consistent with governing state and federal laws;

**NOW THEREFORE** in consideration of the following agreement, the parties do hereby covenant and agree to the following:

**EACH OF THE PARTIES AGREES TO:**

1. Promote a coordinated effort among agencies and staff to achieve maximum public safety with the goal of reducing juvenile crime.
2. Participate in a review and evaluation of the R.A.D.A.R. program, on an as needed basis, but at least annually.
3. Make recommendations for program improvement, when appropriate.
4. Assign staff, as appropriate, to participate in the R.A.D.A.R. program.
5. Develop criteria for the program and cooperative procedures, as needed, to implement this agreement to the maximum extent possible.

**THE DEPARTMENT OF JUVENILE JUSTICE, CIRCUIT II, AGREES TO:**

1. Serve as an active participant in the R.A.D.A.R. program by:
  - Ensuring that all youth considered for referral to the R.A.D.A.R. program has a PACT assessment on file,
  - referring appropriate youth to the program,
  - appointing DJJ staff members to participate in the program,
  - participating in ongoing staffings of R.A.D.A.R. youth,
  - notifying the court, as per Florida Statute, of youth in violation of their court ordered sanctions,
  - making timely referrals for identified service needs as a result of a R.A.D.A.R. contact,
  - providing consequences to youth that receive R.A.D.A.R. violations, and reporting compliance or non-compliance of those consequences back to the R.A.D.A.R. workgroup in a timely manner,
  - filing official violations on youth that are continuously non-compliant.

**THE TALLAHASSEE POLICE DEPARTMENT AGREES TO:**

1. Serve as an active participant in the R.A.D.A.R. program by:
  - Ensuring participation by City of Tallahassee Police Department Officers in the program,
  - appointing a designee to participate in ongoing staffings of R.A.D.A.R. youth,

**THE TALLAHASSEE MARINE INSTITUTE AGREES TO:**

1. Serve as an active participant in the R.A.D.A.R. program by:
  - Referring appropriate youth to the program,
  - appointing THMI staff members to participate in the program,
  - participating in ongoing staffings of R.A.D.A.R. youth,
  - notifying the court, as per Florida Statute, of youth in violation of their court ordered sanctions,
  - making timely referrals for identified service needs as a result of a R.A.D.A.R. contact,
  - providing consequences to youth that receive R.A.D.A.R. violations, and reporting compliance or non-compliance of those consequences back to the R.A.D.A.R. workgroup in a timely manner,
  - filing official violations on youth that are continuously non-compliant

**THE HENRY AND RILLA WHITE FOUNDATION, INC. AGREES TO:**

1. Serve as an active participant in the R.A.D.A.R. program by:
  - Referring appropriate youth to the program,
  - appointing HRWF staff members to participate in the program,
  - participating in ongoing staffings of R.A.D.A.R. youth,
  - notifying the court, as per Florida Statute, of youth in violation of their court ordered sanctions,
  - making timely referrals for identified service needs as a result of a R.A.D.A.R. contact,
  - providing consequences to youth that receive R.A.D.A.R. violations, and reporting compliance or non-compliance of those consequences back to the R.A.D.A.R. workgroup in a timely manner,
  - filing official violations on youth that are continuously non-compliant

**MODIFICATION OF AGREEMENT:**

Modification of this agreement shall be made only by the consent of all parties. Such modifications shall be made with the same formalities as were followed in the original agreement and shall include a written document setting forth the modification, signed by all parties. If any party does not agree to a proposed modification, that party may withdraw from this agreement with 30 days notice.


**PROGRAM REVIEW AND EVALUATION:**

Representatives from the Department of Juvenile Justice, Circuit II; the Tallahassee Police Department; the Tallahassee Marine Institute; and the Henry and Rilla White Foundation, Inc. shall review the R.A.D.A.R. program for effectiveness, timeliness and cost each year. The findings shall be jointly prepared, with recommended changes as appropriate, and submitted to the Chief Probation Officer, Circuit II, Department of Juvenile Justice; the Chief of Police, City of Tallahassee; the Executive Director of the Tallahassee Marine Institute; and the Program Director for the Henry and Rilla White Foundation, Inc., Circuit II Conditional Release program.


Review of this program may be requested at any time by any of the signatory agency heads by written notification of request to the other agency heads. The request shall list the reason for the request and state whether the entire program, or only specific item(s), be reviewed. If any party to this agreement, after review, no longer concurs with the program, concurrence may be withdrawn with 30 days notice.




