<p>1. Welcome and Introductions</p>	<p>Chair Elvin Martinez, Jr. called the meeting to order at 10:03 am. Minutes from the August 17, 2018 meeting were reviewed. Gary White motioned to approve the minutes and Rob Parkinson seconded, minutes approved. Mr. Martinez announced that Lt. Rojka, Jennifer Cristiano and Sarah Blumberg were unable to attend</p>
<p>2. Board Updates</p>	<p>Mr. Martinez announced that Board updates on the agenda will now be changing to Board Priorities.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Probation (Judy Roysden) shortage of substance abuse and mental health commitment beds. In January 2019, 112 more residential beds will be on line. • Civil Citation (Monica Martinez)15 referrals from the community, 18 school based, 33 total, 10 were for possession of marijuana. • Safe & Sound (Freddy Barton) Youth surveys at detention showed lack of mentorship, male role models and access to firearms. CDC taking job training into the center, looking at who else can be partnered with and what else can be done. They had a meeting with PD, DJJ and Motivational Edge on 10/18/2018 about the concept of an evening reporting center in the 33610 area. Will visit an ERC in Duval County. Leerone Benjamin suggested that Career Source be at the table.
<p>2. Committee Reports</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • DV Civil Citation Committee Update (Barbara Coleman provided update on behalf of Lt. Rojka) meeting was held to include DV youth for Civil Citation, there are DV beds available at Lake Magdalene. Rob Parkinson -Civil Citation stakeholders will regroup, contractual changes are pending, need MOU in place. It should be between 12-15 youth per month. Children’s Services, and Rob Parkinson will meet with Commissioner Murman to clarify that the bed space is available. Sharon Streater announced that HOPE has a meeting on Monday night and SAO,

PD and Chief Judge are to report. Gina Justice reported that Judge Ficarrotta is prepared to discuss.

- **Public Awareness Campaign (Rob Parkinson)** discussed the Public Awareness initiative, looking at the data a lot of these youth are getting access to guns from unlocked vehicles. He has advocated to work with Crime Stoppers and the Board of County Commission has a contract with them. Some dollars are allocated to rewards but also allocated to public awareness.
- **Mental Health Court (Gina Justice)** Chief Judge Ficarrotta had a meeting on 10/18/2018, need to create a separate juvenile division in January of 2019. They are still deciding what kids, will start with Incompetent to proceed youth and then opportunities down the road to include other youth.

Hillsborough County School -Chrissy Dorian discussed Senate Bill 1006.08 Schools must be notified of Baker Acts. Cindy Stuart-Hillsborough County submitted their plan to the state, waiting on approval. Elvin requested that this might be the forum for the Youth at Risk Committee to look at. Gina Justice requested that the court be included.

- **Public Service Award (Elvin Martinez)** stated this would be a process in which providers and Juvenile Justice agencies can nominate someone for the public service award. If interested let Elvin Martinez know. The subcommittee will review the applications and select an award recipient. Pat McGhee and Gary White volunteered.
- **Community Connections (Elvin Martinez)** ACTS owns the property and contracts with DJJ. They are searching for a CEO so no progress till they have selected a CEO.
- **JDAI/RED (Elvin Martinez for Sarah Blumberg)** Plan is to send team to Georgetown in March 2019, for the week-long certification course on reducing racial and ethnic disparity. Alachua County has participated, and statistics have plummeted since they learned techniques.
- Keith Babb waiting on approval for background screening on a volunteer that will do the FTA notification calls to the families for upcoming court dates.
- **Membership/By-laws (Elvin Martinez)** it would be beneficial to convene a committee to review the bylaws. The by- laws reflect the processes we follow. Ms. Holt nominated Rocky Brancato to chair that committee Please let him know if you would like to join.
