Call to Order:

Peggy Howland-Chair was absent due to training, Jenny Hill Co-Chair proceeded to call the meeting at 1:31. Introductions were made.

Approval of Minutes:

Jenny Hill motioned the approval of the minutes and David Taylor second the motion.

Treasurer's report:

Unchanged at \$1360.75

Old Business/New Business:

- a. **Family Affair Update:** Peggy Howland will be sending out updates through email next week. Lt. Gatchell did report he will have the climbing wall and is working on other things as well. Wes Johnston volunteered to have the color guard at the Family Affair.
- b. **Liberty Update:** Liberty will be participating. Liberty has already brought things for the event and has had donations made.

Juvenile Justice Council:

There are currently 28 youth being supervised through the Department of Juvenile Justice in the Calhoun County area. 10 who are currently on probation, 15 who are currently on intake status; includes violations of probation, 1 who is

on pre-trial intervention, 1 on post commitment probation, 1 who is commitment status. According to the Department Pact profile, we currently have 1 youth that is high risk to re-offend, 4 who are moderate-high, 6 who are moderate risk, and 13 who are low risk to re-offend. There is currently 1 youth that has absconded from supervision and have a pick up order issued. Burglary has been the top crime committed over the past few months. Fred Womack reported Shaneka Gardner will be serving the Bay County area and introduced Jill Foy who will serve the Calhoun County area.

Calhoun-Liberty Community Outreach: absent

Substance Abuse Coalition

- a. **Survey Update:** David Taylor reported: The survey results are complete and available. CARE, FSU and PAEC applied for the PPG for Calhoun and Liberty. We are hopeful. We updated the SARG approved documents with 2010 FYAS data for the PPG. We will be doing a SARG complete revision soon. The coaches will no longer be in place after June 30th.
- b. **Tobacco Prevention Partnership:** absent but sent in agency report. Pam McDaniel reported: This month is the end of the current contract year. The purchasing for the year is complete and quarterly activities are almost complete. There will be 4 Calhoun County SWAT clubs in the 2010-2013 contract term. The clubs will be at Altha, Carr, BMS and BHS. The Calhoun County Tobacco Free Partnership will be filling the positions of Chair, Co-Chair, and Secretary. Everyone is invited to attend the meetings which are held at the W.T. Neal Civic Center on the third of the month at 3:30 pm.

Healthy Start Advisory Council

- a. **Chipola Healthy Start:** Executive Director Lisa Grice provided copies of a report of Healthy Start program data from all five counties in the Chipola Healthy Start Coalition service area including Liberty. The report showed the numbers of seven key indicators of service for all five counties, as well as the percentage of services that each county represented. She explained that this was the data used to determine the allocation for the Healthy Start dollars for each county and announced that the Calhoun County Health Department had been awarded \$178,533 for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2012, to provide services to mothers and infants in Calhoun and Liberty counties. She also gave out the latest available Billable Services Report that showed both the percentage of billable services and the percentage of births for each of the five counties in relation to the total for the entire CHS service area. She stated that the Medicaid Waiver dollars were allocated by the billable services and that CCHD can earn up to another \$47,134, for a total of \$225,667 for the 2012-2013 fiscal year.

- b. **Calhoun County Healthy Start Program:** Vanessa O'Neal reported the Care Coordinators are staying busy. HS now have car seats, convertibles and infant seats. HS have certified technicians; call Katrina at 643-2415 ext 249 for an appointment.

Advisory Board-Agency reports

- a. **Calhoun County Schools:** Jenny Hill reported: We are closing out projects and writing new ones. Title I doesn't have their application on-line but budgets are due by June 30, 2012. We are looking at continuing the activities we had last year and to add a part-time interpreter for our English Language Learner students. School will begin August 14, 2012 and end on May 24, 2013. I will bring 2012-2013 school calendars for the July meeting.
- b. **Early Learning Coalition:** absent
- c. **North Florida Child Development:** Sue Vickery reported: June 4, 2012 was the last day of school for the head start children participating in the blended program held at Blountstown Elementary School. North Florida Child Development and the Calhoun County School District have completed negotiations and contracts and the plans are to continue having the blended program at the BES site. The early head start site is still in session until July 27, 2012. Plans are being made for an end-of-school-year celebration.
- d. **Healthy Families:** absent
- e. **Domestic Violence:** Lindsey McCrary was present but had nothing to report.
- f. **Department of Children and Families:** absent
- g. **Calhoun County Health Department:** Vanessa O'Neal reported: The clinic is staying busy, under new administrator, changes taking place.
- h. **Big Bend CBC:** Mary Barnes reported: August 11, 2012, Bay and all foster children back to school event 10:00-1:00 at Lynn Haven Recreational Center. School supplies and uniforms to be given out. The number of cases in Calhoun County down (as well in Jackson) which will result in loss of staff. Independent Living program has been redesigned. Now program is part of case management organizations rather than a separate contract.
- i. **Blountstown Public Library:** absent but sent in agency report: Kelly Wyrick reported: The month of June is when the library does its summer reading program. This program is called FLYP. It has been held at BPL each Tuesday from 10:00 until 12:00. Each branch is participating and has its own program day. This is going well. It has been great fun for us and the children. This month we will have done 5 programs with the child cares with the "On the road story times", 9 PACT story times, and 4 FLYP programs, as well as 2 to 3 story times with the BES summer school children. The library is also having a FLYP 4 art program on the 30th of June. By the end of the month there will have been about 500 in attendance for these programs.

Frances and I attended the ELC Parenting Conference in P.C., it was very good. The goal is to share the conscious discipline guidelines with the parents. They should find the information very informative and useful.

- j. **FLNG CD COP:** Lt. Gatchell reported FLNG CD COP (Civil Operations Program) continues to serve Calhoun County as requested. I am planning on attending the Family Affair with the FLNG Rock wall, however have had limited success on getting a committed for the requested color guard and military vehicle. The FLNG CD COP primary focus for FY13 is coalition support and secondary focus will be to work within schools instructing leadership, life skills and drug prevention education. Schools that want the FLNG COP programs must be requested through the coalition. Any and all services that the coalition needs in support of their anti-drug nexus can be requested through Lt. Gatchell and the FLNG CD COP.

At 2:33 Jenny Hill made a motion to adjourn the meeting, Vanessa O'Neal second it.
