For mental health services direct supervision of the non-licensed mental health clinical staff person must be provided by a licensed mental health professional (a psychiatrist licensed under Chapter 458 or 459, psychologist licensed under Chapter 490, a clinical social worker, mental health counselor, or marriage and family counselor licensed under Chapter 491, F.S., or a psychiatric nurse under Section 394.455(23), F.S.)

For substance abuse services direct supervision of the non-licensed substance abuse clinical staff person must be provided in accordance with Rule 65D-30.003(15) FAC. A non-licensed substance abuse clinical staff person may provide substance abuse services only as an employee of a service provider licensed under Chapter 397 or in a facility licensed under Chapter 397. Direct supervision of the non-licensed substance abuse clinical staff person must be provided by a "qualified professional" as defined in Section 397.311(25) which means a physician licensed under Chapter 458 or 459, a professional licensed under chapter 490 or 491 or a person who is certified through a DCF recognized certification process for substance abuse treatment.

The licensed mental health professional or "qualified professional" must provide Direct Supervision at least one hour per week for each non-licensed mental health clinical staff person or non-licensed substance abuse clinical staff person.
