Additions to the existing MAYSI have been made to step 7 of 7 under “Service Response” to capture additional information as seen below:

New Service Response:

The “Override of MAYSI results and referral made due to observations or collateral information” has been changed to include a Mandatory “Override Reason” dialog box if selected. The user will be required to enter data in the “Override Reason” box to indicate why the user selected the Override option.

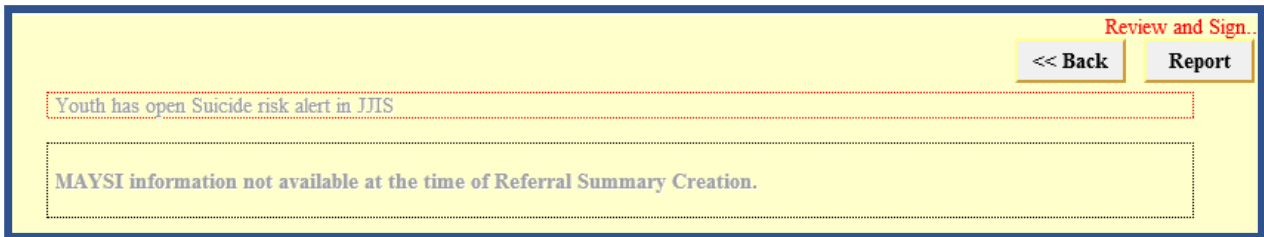
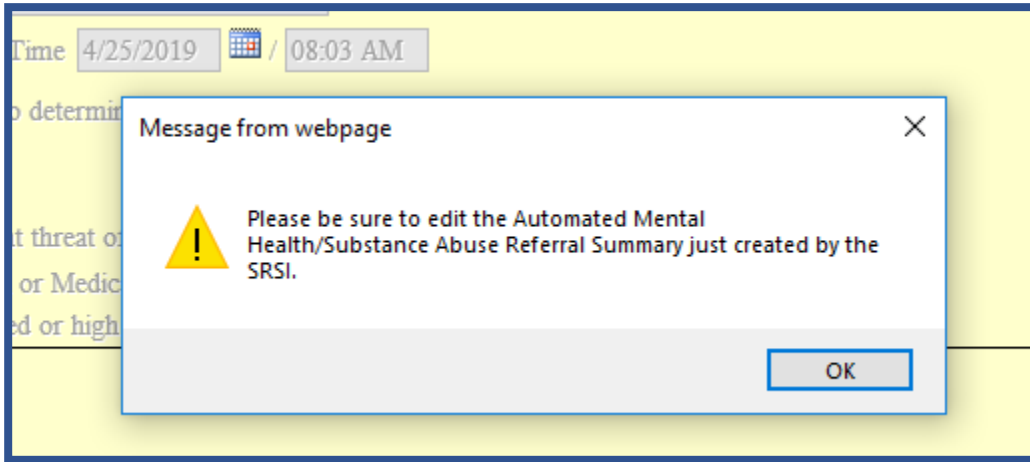
