Florida RED/DMC Action Plan Circuit 13

*Relative Rate Index (RRI) is the OJJDP-recommended measure of DMC/RED. The RRI, ranging from zero to infinite positive numbers, compares the occurrence rate of minority youth to the occurrence rate of white youth within various points of the juvenile justice continuum of services.

National RRI: 3.0

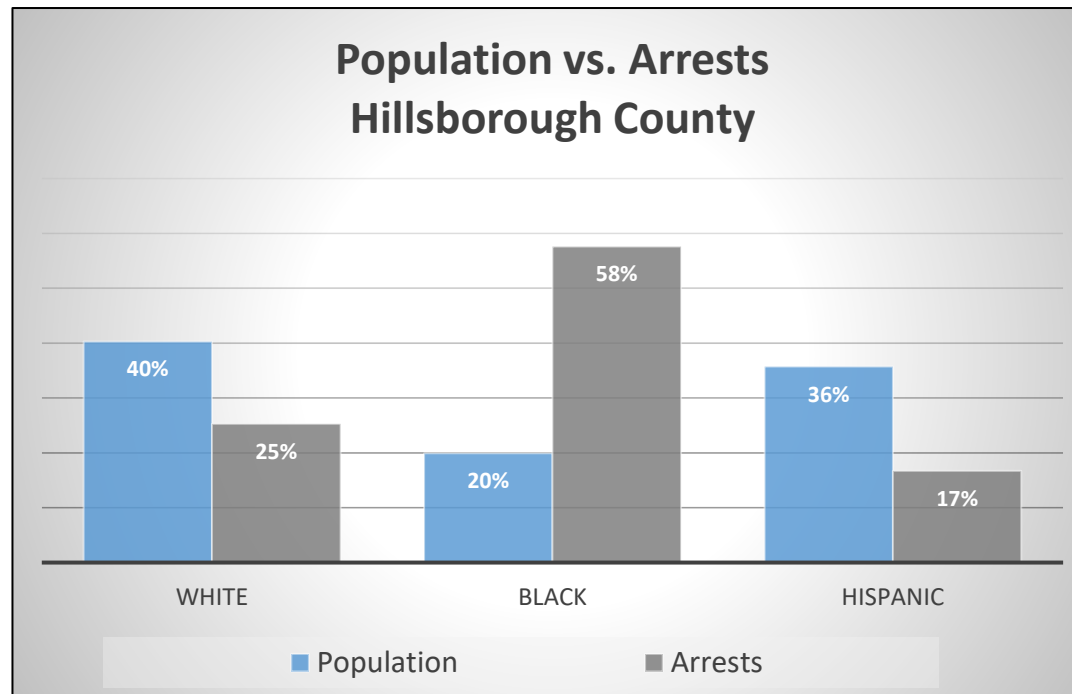
State RRI: 3.1

Hillsborough County RRI: 4.6

(Decrease of 0.5 from FY 16-17)

Hillsborough County ranked 11th highest RRI in Florida

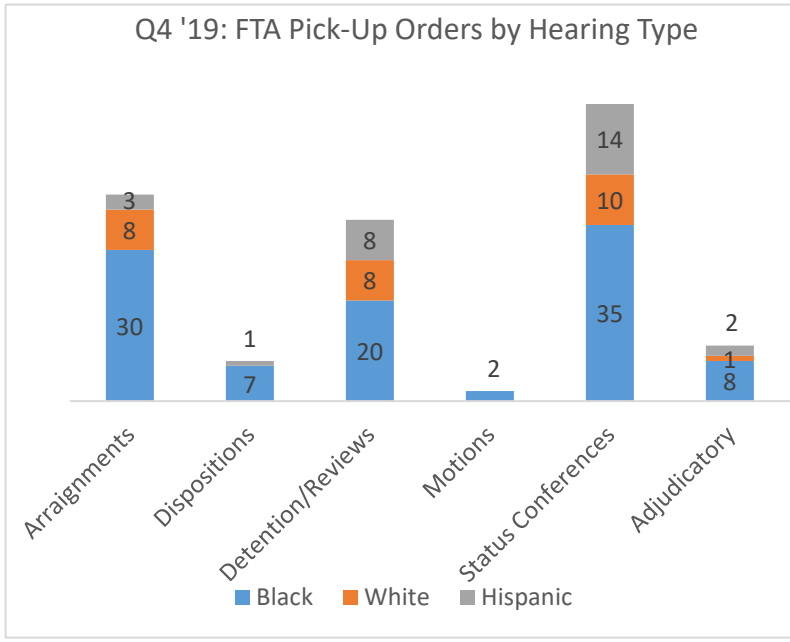
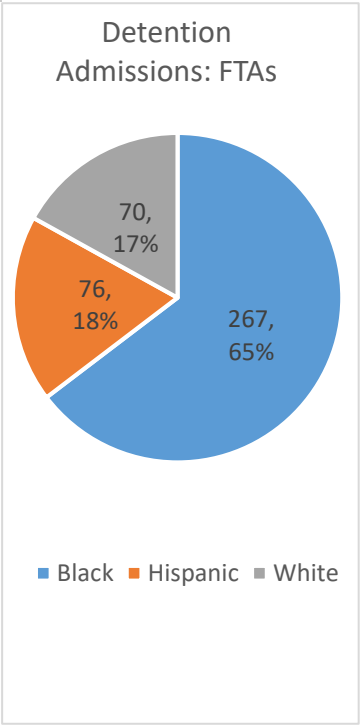
