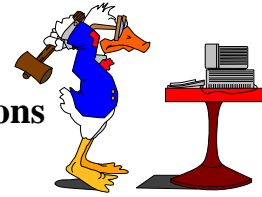

******* JJIS, CJNET and Seal & Expunge Security Plan**

The following security features have been added to JJIS, CJNET and Seal & Expunge:

- **Password Complexity** – password format (upper, lower, & number)
- **Security Questions screen** - questions and answers defined by user to reset his/her password. User can reset their password by answering security question.
- **Manage Security Questions (on login page & Home page)** – allows user to modify Security questions.
- **Reset/Forgot Password** - on login screen, for User access.
- **Change Password** - on login screen, for User access.
- **Security Code (CAPTCHA)** – a feature that’s added to the change password screen to check for suspicious activity (human or machine).
- **OHS EMR Module** - Changes for Electronic Signature, which was impacted by Password Encryption.
