Purpose: The Florida Department of Juvenile Justice (DJJ) is committed to evaluating our approach to juvenile justice to ensure increased public safety in our communities and best outcomes for the youth we serve. As outlined in Section 985.245, F.S., our Department, in conjunction with statutorily required members of the community, is tasked with the development, implementation, and evaluation of a detention risk assessment instrument (DRAI) for determinations and court orders regarding placement of a child into detention care.

Committee members will be provided with an overview of the data-driven analysis conducted and an overview of the newly proposed instrument. A decision on the implementation of the new instrument will be made at the culmination of this meeting.
