Subject: HEALTH RELATED HISTORY			Reference: 63M-2.047 7 63M-2.041 F.A.C. Quality Improvement Standard 4.14	
Purpose:	The purpose of this policy is to outline in detail the process for conducting or reviewing admission history.			

PROCEDURE:

- A. The Health Related History shall be completed no later than seven (7) calendar days following the date of admission and prior to the youth being subjected to extreme outdoor weather conditions including, but not limited to, high heat indices and frigid temperatures.
- B. The Health Related History shall be conducted or reviewed by a nurse through interview of the youth. It will then be made available to the Designated Health Authority or Physician Designee, PA, or ARNP, prior to conducting or reviewing the Comprehensive Physical Assessment (CPA) or completed by the practitioner at the time of the CPA.
- C. When a youth re-enters the department's custody or is placed in another facility, a nurse, together with the youth, shall review the Health-Related History. Corrections and revisions shall be made at this time and documented on the page reserved for this purpose.
- D. Nursing assessments, including a summary of the health-related issues of the youth, shall be documented.
- E. Medical Alerts based on the history are to be implemented as applicable in a timely manner.
- F. Youth are to only be re-screened by the receiving facility whenever they are moved from one facility to another with an anticipated stay of 24 hours or more. Consideration shall be made if the previous provider and current practitioner are the same and no significant changes to the youth's health has occurred.
